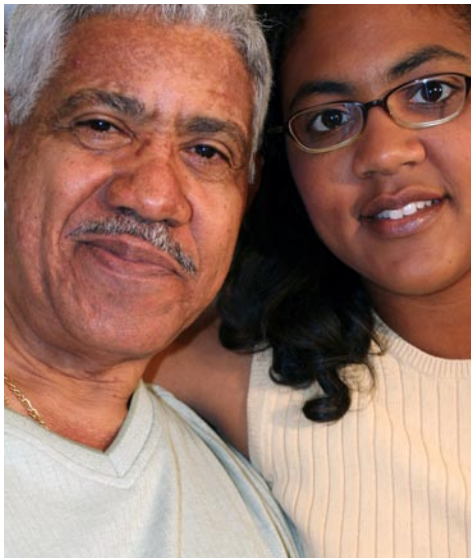
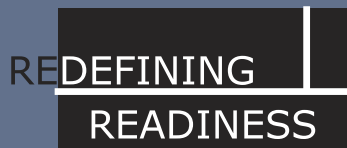

The cards are grouped in three sections:

COLOR CODES

Green cards: Introduce or summarize the findings from the small group discussions
